John Eberle LEEBRICK (Dec. 31, 1834-?)



John E. Leebrick was born Dec. 31, 1834. In 1860, he was living in Halifax and working as a teacher of the common school. He was then living with his widowed father, John Philip Leebrick, a farmer, and a brother, George Thomas Leebrick, age 18, who was listed in the 1860 Census as a "gentleman." During the Civil War, John served in the 23rd Pennsylvania Infantry, Company B, as a Private, from 2 August 1861 through 8 September 1864.

The spelling of the Leebrick surname is also found as Lebrick, Liebrich, Liebrick, Leibrich, and Liebrick.
