

John Eberle LEEBRICK (Dec. 31, 1834- ?)



John E. Leebrick was born Dec. 31, 1834. In 1860, he was living in **Halifax** and working as a teacher of the common school. He was then living with his widowed father, **John Philip Leebrick**, a farmer, and a brother, **George Thomas Leebrick**, age 18, who was listed in the 1860 Census as a “gentleman.” During the Civil War, John served in the **23rd Pennsylvania Infantry**, Company B, as a Private, from 2 August 1861 through 8 September 1864.

The spelling of the Leebrick surname is also found as Lebrick, Liebrich, Liebrick, Leibrich, and Liebrick.
