Manhiem via Hamburg
Settled in Manheim,
Lancaster county,
Pennsylvania
Descendents switched
the spelling to Leebrick
about 1830

(b 1796)
Arrived in Philadelphia
1832-1835 from
Sippersfeld via
Settled in Butler Co,
OH, wife Sophia,
several children in
Butler Co.
Name was spelled
Liverick in US.

Conrad Liebrich (b
1810)
Arrived in Philadelphia
in 1837 from
Settled in Philadelphia,
wife Anna, 4 children in
PA
Was a prolific inventor,
with numerous US
patents on locks and
children's toys
in 1845 from
Settled in

Settled in Daartown,
Butler Co, OH

(Daartown)
Anna Marie married
Hertzell, had issue Otto
and Lena
Augustina married
Frank Henrich Pandorf,
